BMA salary negotiations 2025/26: VOTING NOW OPEN

Voting open: Monday, 17 March 2025 at 09:00

The previous *Informus* issued on 14 March 2025, outlined the salary negotiation process and the employer's final offer. As negotiations between the BMA and the PSA continue outside the Public Service Coordinating Bargaining Council, your mandate is now required.
