- Generate reports of the employer's non-compliance with laws and collective agreements regulating terms and conditions of employment.
- Represent the PSA and participate in collective bargaining processes.
- Execute any other duties that may be assigned by the PSA.
- Recruitment (please note that a weekly target exists) and retaining members.
- Arrange and attend meetings with members and stakeholders
