Update: Limpopo PHSDSBC Annual General Meeting (AGM) 25 April 2025

The Limpopo Public Health and Social Development Bargaining Chamber (PHSDSBC) held its AGM on 25 April 2025 and the following items were discussed.

Annual General Meeting

The Secretary reported that the Council is satisfied with the smooth running of the chamber for the financial year 2024/2025. The working relationship between the employer and organised labour is very good. Parties managed to resolve 80 % of the agenda items, and few of them were removed from the agenda in agreement with both parties. There were task teams that were established in 2024/2025, and they are yielding good results as they are updating the chamber with progress of resolving the items. During the financial year 2024/2025, the PSA forwarded many agenda items such as the Occupational and Health Safety (OHS) in Hospitals and Clinics, safety, and security of staff in the clinics and hospitals and termination of Community Health Care workers (CHWs), termination of membership deduction for unknown reasons etc. PSA members are well represented in the chamber and the Union is still the majority Union. The representatives managed to attend all six meetings, special meetings, caucuses, and they form part of the task team.

Elections of Chamber management

The Management Committee was elected, and labour nominated PSA Secretary Ms. Nkhensani Maluleke as the Chamber Chairperson and the employer nominated Mr. Reuben Mabilu from the Department of Social Development as the Vice Chairperson.
